

# Restrictions on Shipping Hazmat Items

The U.S. Department of Transportation defines a hazardous material (hazmat) as any item or chemical which, when being transported or moved in commerce, is a risk to public safety or the environment. This includes all paints, dopes, cleaning chemicals, batteries, and pressurized spray cans sold by Univair. The table below lists the restrictions Univair follows when shipping hazmat materials.

Hazmat Restrictions and Fees	
International address	Univair will not ship hazmat items outside the United States.
Alaska and Hawaii	Univair will not ship hazmat items to these states.
P.O. Boxes	Carriers will not deliver hazmat items to Post Office boxes. A building address is required.
Small containers under 5 gallons	Will be shipped via <a href="#">UPS Ground</a> only. A <b>\$25.00 hazmat fee</b> will be added to UPS shipping costs. Can also be included in motor freight shipments at no additional cost.
5 gallon cans	Will be shipped via <a href="#">Motor Freight</a> only. No hazmat fee added.
55 gallon drums	Will be shipped via <a href="#">Motor Freight</a> only. Additional <b>drum fee CR8</b> will be added.
Free Ground Shipping	Hazmat items are excluded from our Free Ground Shipping promotion.
Free Motor Freight Shipping	Hazmat items are included in the Free Motor Freight Shipping promotion provided all other qualifying conditions are met. See <a href="#">Free Shipping From Univair</a> for details.
